Items We Cannot Accept

While it is hard to say “no” to donations, Goodwill Columbus is sometimes unable to accept certain items. Items should be dry and clean. We will accept stained or damaged items, which we recycle. Management reserves the right to refuse any donation. Unfortunately, we cannot accept items including, but not limited to:

- MATTRESS AND BOX SPRINGS
- SOFA BEDS, WATER BEDS
- FIREARMS
- TVs (CONSOLE, CRT TUBE-STYLE)
- LARGE APPLIANCES (i.e. REFRIGERATORS, WASHERS, DRYERS, DISHWASHERS, STOVES, OR HVAC UNITS)
- ANY CHEMICALS, PAINTS, FLAMMABLE LIQUIDS
- HOT TUBS, TOILETS, SINKS, POOLS
- WET OR SOILED CLOTHING
- FURNITURE THAT NEEDS ANY TYPE OF REPAIR OR CLEANING
- INFANT FURNITURE AND SAFETY DEVICES OR ANY CPSC-RECALLED ITEMS (Items donated will be recycled.)
- CARPET THAT NEEDS CLEANING OR THAT'S IN NEED OF REPAIR
- DOORS, WINDOWS, BLINDS, BUILDING SUPPLIES
- ITEMS CONTAINING FUEL SUCH AS GASOLINE PROPANE (PLEASE REMOVE FUEL PRIOR TO DONATING)
